## Flood Emergency Response in NWFP

Year 2008 proved to be a challenging year for the people of few districts of NWFP. On one side, people faced unpredictable law and order situation and on the other, natural disaster ruined the inhabitants of Peshawar. Almost twelve union councils were horribly hit by sudden and torrential waves of Local River. In order to respond to the affected people, HRDS implemented a project - Flood Emergency Response in NWFP- in four affected union councils, with financial support from UNICEF.

There was chaotic situation in the area; houses were entirely damaged and there was no question of safe drinking water and sanitation. Stagnant water was promoting health threats in the community. Food provision was not up to the mark and people were suffering from different diseases. HRDS distributed different non-food items in the area.

- Distribution of hygiene kits
- Installation of pit latrine
- Chlorination of water for making it drinkable
- Conduction of hygiene sessions

## Voucher/Token Distribution

HRDS issued cards as a token to the affected people, for the delivery of the relief goods. The purpose of the token was to make the distribution process simple and easy. Teams visited the villages, issued tokens to the affected people and then distributed relief items.



## Hygiene Kit Distribution

The drinking water sources were found contaminated and people were suffering from different water borne diseases.

Hygiene sessions were arranged to overcome diseases in the area, in which an orientation on PUR Sachet and Aqua tabs was also given to the people. FER teams distributed PUR Sachets as a measure to overcome diseases in the area. There was mutual discussion during the sessions and following topics were covered.
